

Policies and Procedures for our Outdoor Service

1. No person who is sick with COVID-19 symptoms, or who has been in close proximity to anyone else that is sick, shall be permitted to attend and participate in the service.
2. Congregational singing is permitted during this service. Please remember that even though singing is safer outside because of the open air, singing still presents a risk because singing produces aerosols. Please exercise caution when singing.
3. It is recommended, but not required, to wear a mask unless Cobb County becomes a red level county based on globalepidemics.org.
4. All participants shall maintain a safe social distance of at least six feet or more from one another at all times. Please refrain from hugging and shaking hands.
5. Each participant shall be required to bring their own chair.
6. Hand sanitizer will be made available for all worshippers.
7. In the event of inclement weather, the outdoor service will be canceled.
8. Every attendee is prayerfully encouraged to remember the needs of other people.
9. Indoor bathroom will be available for emergencies. Please limit one family or person at a time.
